### A note from the counselor:

Children need a lot of modeling and support when it comes to decision making. It is a skill that develops over time as children mature. When children are demonstrating problem solving skills, they think through the consequences of their actions- positive or negative. Good choices stem from working through a deliberate decision-making process, not impulse. In order to make positive, healthy and safe choices, children are encouraged to pause and take a time out (calming down if upset), think about the problem they are facing and the options they have, and then make the best decision for themselves. Children are capable of making decisions they can be proud of!

### Making Good Decisions at Home:

#### HOME CONNECTION--

- GIVE KIDS CHOICES WHEN YOU CAN. THESE LITTLE CHOICES- LIKE WHAT THEY WILL WEAR OR WHAT THEY WILL EAT WILL BE GOOD PRACTICE FOR BIG CHOICES.
- MODEL YOUR OWN DECISION-MAKING PROCESS. TALK ALOUD ABOUT THE PROS AND CONS AND ALTERNATIVES. HOW DOES THIS DECISION MAKE ME FEEL? HOW WILL THIS DECISION IMPACT OTHERS?
- REINFORCE GOOD CHOICES WITH PRAISE (TRY LOOKING OUT FOR THESE POSITIVE MOMENTS INSTEAD OF THE "I TOLD YOU SO" MOMENTS).
- AS MUCH AS WE TRY TO PROTECT THEM, CHILDREN MAKE MISTAKES. DURING THIS TIME, THEY WILL GAIN INSIGHT, AND LOOK TO YOU FOR GUIDANCE, SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT. THIS IS A GOOD TIME TO HAVE RESTORATIVE CONVERSATIONS!
