Before coming onsite to a CPS building please review the following questions.

Please note:

Next Steps:

- If “No” to all, you are allowed to enter the building.
- If “Yes” to question 1, you must stay home and contact your primary care provider for next steps.
- If “Yes” to question 2, you must stay home to complete the 14-day quarantine from the last time you were a close contact.
- If “Yes” to question 3, you must review the following guidance:
 - Domestic travel must follow the CDPH travel order, anyone traveling from a state on the Orange list is directed to obtain a negative COVID-19 test result no more than 72 hours prior to arrival in Chicago or quarantine for a 10-day period.

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- If “Yes” to question 4, you must review the following guidance:
 - Travelers coming from international locations are not covered by this Order and should follow [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines](#).
 - Obtain a negative COVID-19 test result 3-5 days after travel **AND** stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel.
 - If your student does not get tested, they should stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
 - Please note even if the test is negative, stay home and self-quarantine for the full 7 days
- If “Yes” to question 5, you must stay home to wait on your test results.
- If “Yes” to question 6, you must stay home until you have completed 10 days of isolation (that starts on the first day of your symptom) **AND** 24 hours since your last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications **AND** your other symptoms are improving
