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Tutoring Chicago offers free one-to-one tutoring services to economically disadvantaged children in grades 1-6. Parents must accurately and honestly complete financial information on their applications. Serving families with financial need is the mission of our organization.

Students are matched one-to-one with adult, volunteer tutors. All of our volunteers attend orientation and submit a background check before beginning tutoring. Your child will meet with the same tutor every week. (Some students have two tutors.)



**Program Details:**

SMART tutoring focuses on Social Skills, Math, Attitude and Attendance, Reading, and Technology for students in grades 1-6. They meet once a week for 90mins. Students and tutors work together on Monday, Tuesday, OR Wednesday from 6:00pm-7:30pm.

Literacy Intensive Tutoring (LIT) is an early intervention program for struggling readers in grades 1-4. Students meet with their tutors twice a week, on Monday AND Tuesday, from 6:00pm-7:30pm.
